



Make your own Herbarium!

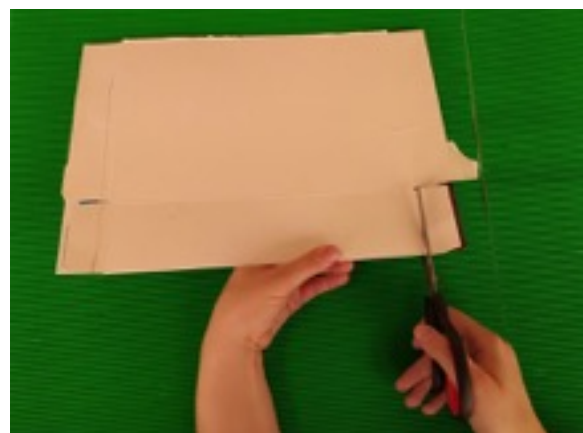
Materials

Pressed specimens of plants
White sheets of paper (A4 size)
Transparent paper cut in sheets (A4 size)
Thin cardboard or cardboard box (cereal box)
Yarn or cotton twine
Scissors
Pencil
Craft glue and small brush
Hole puncher
Markers, crayons (optional)

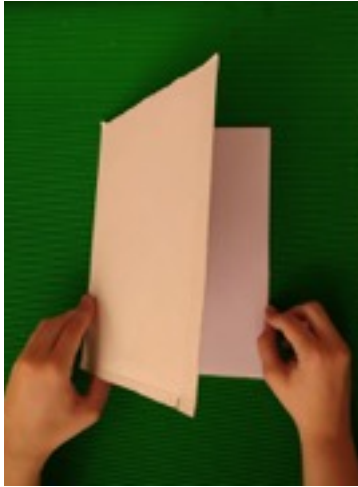


Instructions

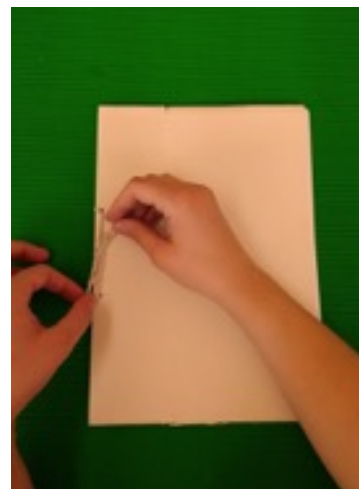
1. Fold the cardboard in half and cut it to the size of the sheets of paper (A4).



2. Place a sheet of transparent paper upon each sheet of white paper. Place them all together inside the cardboard.
3. Use the hole puncher to make two holes through the cardboard and all the sheets (If the sheets do not fit along with the cardboard at the hole puncher, you can drill them separately but make sure that the holes are in the same place).



4. Tie a piece of twine through the holes.



- Carefully glue the pressed plants on the A4 white sheets of paper and let them dry. Write a label for each plant in your collection.



- Decorate the cover of your herbarium with markers, crayons, stickers, stamps and whatever else you want.
